GENERAL INFORMATION

CalPower is a liquid macronutrient with Calcium, Nitrogen, and sea plant extract. It is designed for use on all crops.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Put 1/3 to 2/3 of total water volume in tank. **1.** Add pesticide(s) if desired and agitate until thoroughly mixed. **2.** Add CalPower and agitate until thoroughly mixed. **3.** Add adjuvant(s) if desired and agitate until thoroughly mixed. Fill tank with remainder of desired water. A jar test is recommended for evaluating compatibility of CalPower with multiple product mixtures.

CAUTION: Do not mix with fertilizers containing phosphorous. Check compatibility with chemical mixtures and high phosphate and alkaline (high pH) solutions.

SOIL APPLICATION

CalPower can be applied pre-plant or side-dressed at 1–2 gallons per acre.

FOLIAR APPLICATION

General Use for All Field Crops, Fruits, and Vegetables: Apply 1–4 quarts of CalPower per acre throughout the growing season. Dilute in an adequate amount of water for thorough coverage. Frequent applications may be needed to correct deficiencies should they occur. Pre-bloom and bloom applications may be made. It is important to apply CalPower early for vegetable and berry crops. Frequent applications are beneficial.

Apples, Peaches, and Tree Fruit: Begin first application after petal fall.

Ornamental Crops: Apply 1–2 quarts of CalPower per 100 gallons of water. Cover foliage thoroughly to the point of runoff.

CAUTION

Keep out of the reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid

contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash hands thoroughly after use. **Personal Protective Equipment:** Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes, and gloves.

FIRST AID

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 minutes.

If in eyes: Flush eyes immediately and thoroughly for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes.

If swallowed: Call a doctor or poison control center for treatment advice. Have the person drink a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the doctor or poison control center. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move the person to fresh air. If the person is not breathing, call 911, then give artificial respiration, if possible.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. Store in a cool, dry, locked area out of the reach of children. Protect from excessive heat or cold. Triple-rinse and dispose of container in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.
