## GENERAL INFORMATION

Spreader820 is a nonionic surfactant adjuvant. It is designed to use with pesticides that require a nonionic surfactant. It may also be used with most insecticides, herbicides, fungicides, desiccants, and defoliants. Spreader820 increases contact activity through faster wetting, aids in penetration, and provides uniform coverage of sprays.

## MIXING INSTRUCTIONS/GROUND AND AERIAL

Follow herbicide/pesticide manufacturer's labeled recommendations. Otherwise, Spreader820 may be used as shown on a per-100-gallon basis of final spray mix. Use the higher rate for adequate wetting with hard water.

APPLICATIONS	Use Rate per 100 Gallons of Mix
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Defoliants	1–2 pints
Desiccants	1–2 pints
Fungicides	1/2 to 1 pint
Herbicides	1–2 pints
Insecticides	1/2 to 1 pint

Spreader820 nonionic surfactant should be the last ingredient added to the spray mixture. Agitate to ensure thorough mixing. Always refer to the pesticide and additive label(s) for additional directions or precautions. Follow the most restrictive label.

## CAUTION

Keep out of the reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash hands thoroughly after use. **Personal Protective Equipment:** Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes, and gloves.

## FIRST AID

**If on skin or clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 minutes.

**If in eyes:** Flush eyes immediately and thoroughly for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes.

**If swallowed:** Call a doctor or poison control center for treatment advice. Have the person drink a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the doctor or poison control center. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If inhaled:** Move the person to fresh air. If the person is not breathing, call 911, then give artificial respiration, if possible.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. Store in a cool, dry, locked area out of the reach of children. Protect from excessive heat or cold. Triple-rinse and dispose of container in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.
