Apply Pepper Spray prior to or at the earliest onset of animal browsing or feeding. Repetitive applications may be necessary to maintain effectiveness after rainfall or as new growth occurs.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: Put 1/3 to 2/3 of total water volume in tank. 1. Add pesticide(s) if desired and agitate until thoroughly mixed. 2. Add Pepper Spray and agitate until thoroughly mixed. 3. Add adjuvant(s) if desired and agitate until thoroughly mixed. Fill tank with remainder of desired water. A jar test is recommended for evaluating compatibility of Pepper Spray with multiple product mixtures.

USE RATES (FOLIAR): 1-2 pt/acre. If applying Pepper Spray alone with a fungicide or insecticide, an extender/sticker is recommended to give it longer-lasting effect. If tank-mixing with herbicides, do not add an extender/sticker, but add only a surfactant or water conditioner as an adjuvant. 10–15 gallons of water is the optimum amount of carrier per acre.
